MEANDER is an exciting experimental combination of bookends and bookshelves. Can a furniture accessory emphasise our decorative books/albums while retaining book storage as an original function? Can the book and bookend form unity? These are some of the questions Ádám Miklósi sought to answer when designing MEANDER. The product was inspired by mid-century modern magazine holders, but lacked the complex wavy-line design. It was essential to keep the meanderlike shape and maintain a clean aesthetic quality without becoming overly playful.

The designer optimised the dimensions to accommodate small books or albums as a display furniture accessory. The MEANDER can be used as a stand-alone display to store and display our favourite books, magazines, and albums on a sideboard or wall shelf as a classic bookend or as a bookcase organiser. An optional extension element is also available, allowing users to customise the length and create a modular composition tailored to their needs.
